
1. Copy the se

6. Put left foot onto the paper in the box labeled "left foot". Trace the left foot with a brightly colored marker.
7. Put right foot onto the paper in the box labeled "right foot". Using the same colored marker or a different colored marker, trace the right foot.
8. Have the child wash the marker off his or her feet.
9. Clean up!



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Left and Right - Painted Feet


Paint and print a child's feet to teach him or her the difference between left and right!

Materials Needed:

- 8 1/2 x 11 brightly colored construction paper
- Brightly colored markers
- Several paper plates
- Paint brushes
- Tempra paint
- Child's feet!

Instructions:

1. Copy the second page of the worksheet onto a piece of brightly colored construction paper.
2. Using brightly colored markers, draw a box at the top of the page labeled "left foot" and a box at the bottom of the page labeled "right foot".
3. Using brightly colored markers, draw a box at the top of the page labeled "left foot" and a box at the bottom of the page labeled "right foot".
4. Pour different colors of tempera paint into separate bowls.
5. Make sure the child's feet are clean.
6. Brush child's left foot with enough paint to make a good imprint. Press left foot onto the paper in the box labeled "left foot".
7. Using the same color paint or a different color paint, brush child's right foot with enough paint to make a good imprint. Press right foot onto the paper in the box labeled "right foot".
8. Have the child immediately wash the paint off his or her feet.
9. Lay paper out to dry. Clean up!



Left and Right - Glitter Feet

Trace and glitter a child's feet to teach him or her the difference between left and right!

Materials Needed:

- 8 1/2 x 11 brightly colored construction paper
- Brightly colored markers
- Pencil
- Bottled glue (not g
- Colored glitter
- Child's feet!

Instructions:

1. Copy the second page of the worksheet onto a piece of construction paper.
2. Using brightly colored markers, draw the top of the left and right foot on the paper.
3. Using brightly colored markers, draw the bottom of the left and right foot on the paper.
4. Make sure the construction paper is flat on a clean, flat surface.
5. Place the construction paper on a clean, flat surface.
6. In pencil, trace the child's left foot onto the paper in the box labeled "left foot".
7. Trace the child's right foot onto the paper in the box labeled "right foot".
8. Go over the traced footprint lines with glue.
9. Sprinkle with colored glitter making sure to cover all the glue.
10. Pour off excess glitter.
11. Lay paper out to dry.
12. Clean up!
